**WAR IS
NOT OVER**

Dear friends, partners, and supporters,

As we in Ukraine look back on 2024, we do so with hearts heavy from loss, but determined in our resolve. The war continues. We are exhausted. We are grieving. We have lost friends, territory, and resources. And yet — we do not surrender. We cannot.

In 2024, Russian forces seized key cities in eastern Ukraine, including Avdiivka, Selydove, and Vuhledar. Their loss was a strategic and emotional blow, but our defenders continued to fight, holding the line against overwhelming force. In August, a historic event happened: Ukraine conducted an operation on Russian soil in the Kursk region. This marked a turning point, demonstrating to the world our ability to take the fight to the enemy and, most importantly, protect our cities. Today, Russian bombs fall on Sudzha instead of Sumy because of this resistance. Our defenders have also dealt severe blows to Russia's Black Sea Fleet in 2024, forcing their warships to flee Sevastopol. None of these happened without sacrifice. Victories come at a price: paid in the lives of our soldiers, many of whom were our friends, our colleagues, and our family. We owe it to them to press on. To keep going. To win.

We at Dzyga's Paw are doing our part, but that is not always enough. This year, our founder, Dimko, one team member, and two volunteers joined the Armed Forces. Their decisions debunk the narrative that Ukrainians are tired and unwilling to fight and challenge the narrative of fatigue and apathy. Quite the opposite: we make hard choices, step forward, continue to fight, and constantly look for ways to do even more, because this is our home.

Yet, our foundation is more than just individuals. We have built processes and a system that ensures our work is never dependent on any person alone. This is a sign of our maturity as an organization. Because of this structure, and, most importantly, because of you, our supporters, we have continued to deliver tangible impact.

We sustained and grew our support for Ukraine's Armed Forces despite declining global attention in 2024. Compared to 2023, we supplied the Armed Forces with 33.5% more critical equipment. We did this thanks to long-time supporters, and to the over two thousand new donors, who joined us last year.

None of this would have been possible without you. Whether you have stood with us from the beginning or joined our mission this year, your support fuels everything we do to save the lives of the defenders on the frontlines and maximize the effectiveness of our units.

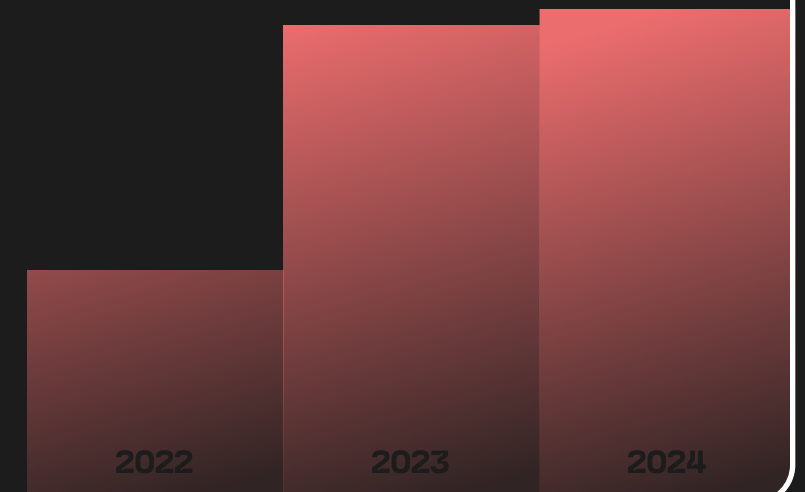

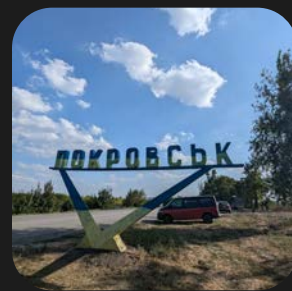

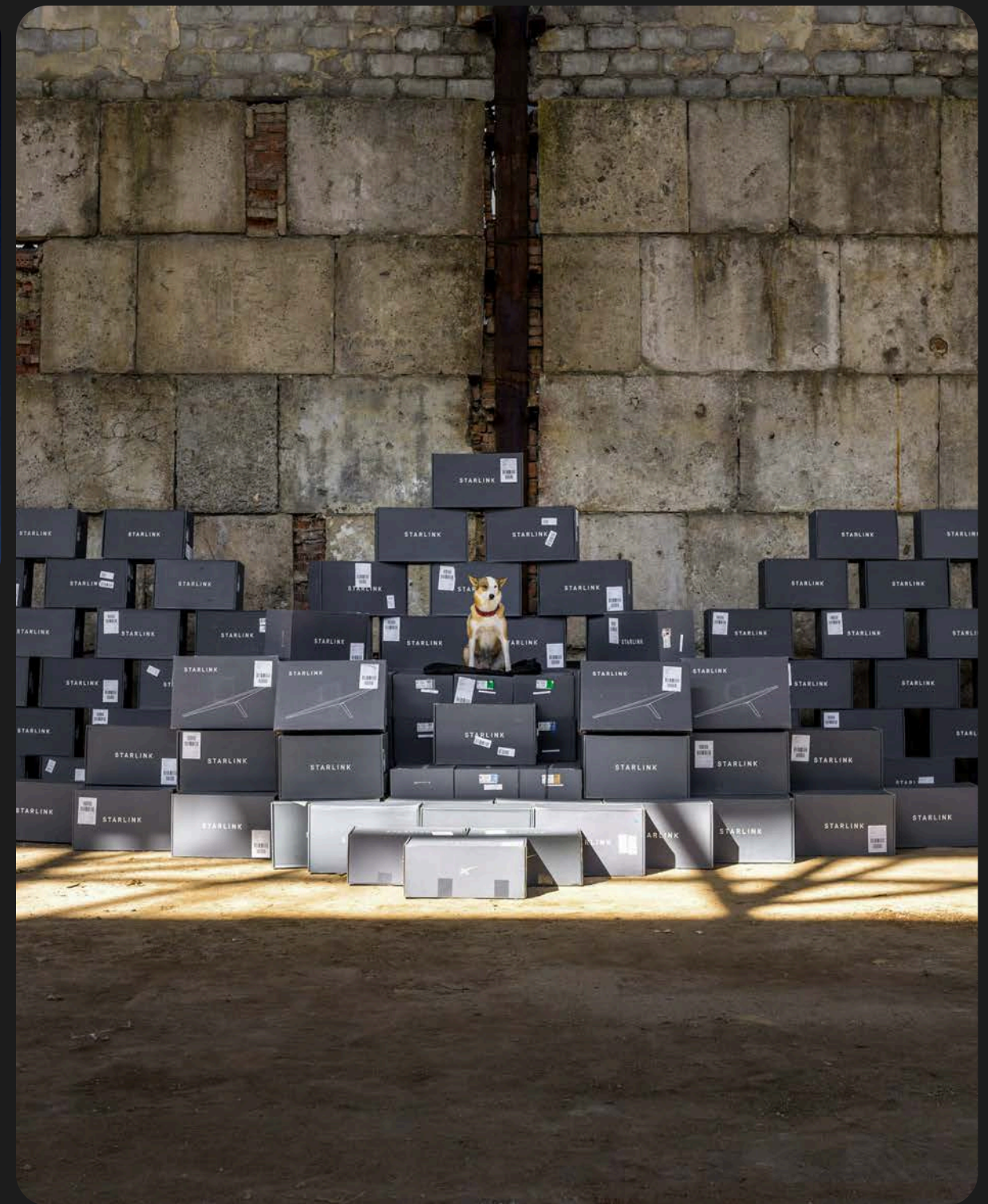

During the spring and summer, we launched two Starlink projects, raising over \$85,000 in total. This funding enabled us to deliver more than 320 Starlink terminals to the frontline.

Dzyga's Paw has proven expertise in providing connectivity to Ukraine's defenders.



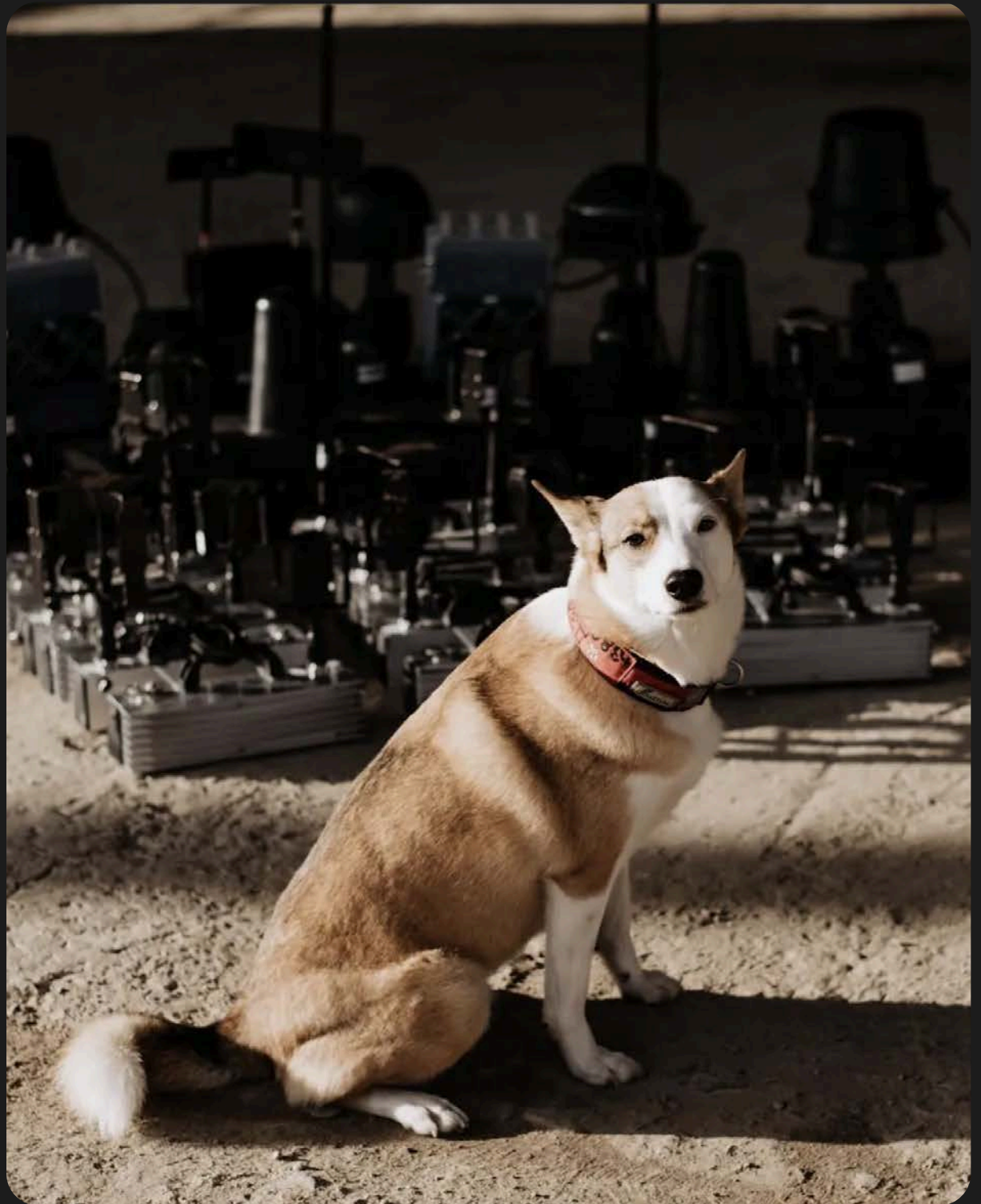


JAM SESSION



The biggest fundraiser of 2024, launched by Dzyga's Paw in November, aimed to raise \$100,000 for anti-drone equipment. In just one month, we surpassed that goal by over \$27,000.

Between December 2024 and January 2025, we delivered 57 pieces of Anti Drone Equipment to 13 different units, providing critical protection on the front lines.

Over the Black Friday weekend Dzyga's Paw raised \$31,757 that was directed to support Jam Session Fundraiser.

Our 5 donors partnered with us and donated \$14,000 to match other donations during that day and double the amount raised for Jam Session!



NAFO BEER RAFFLE



In summer 2024 partnered with Pravda Brewery in Lviv, Ukraine, Aeronaut Brewing co. in Somerville, MA, USA to create special NAFO beer and to raffle them off for donation!

We raised over \$25,000 and delivered 7 night-vision drones to the 93rd Brigade. NAFO beer is now available to buy at breweries websites and part of proceeds goes to Dzyga's Paw projects.

At the end of 2024 we implemented the most magical and kind project that directly connected our supporters worldwide with the Ukrainian military at frontlines.

66 people joined us as Secret Santas and 55 gifts were delivered by our team directly to defenders.

Part of the gifts was sent personally by Santas from their countries, other donated so we could buy gifts in Ukraine and from local producers. Total amount donated: \$16,410.

We are thrilled to support a Ukrainian initiatives by purchasing drones manufactured in Ukraine, instead of opting for Chinese alternatives.

In June in partnership with Sabotage Wine Festival we raised \$30,831 and bought 3 Galka UAS with ground control stations.

ZDF media team joined us to deliver those UAS' to 14th regiment and made a great reportage for German media about it.
